College Insurance

Personal Items – Students

The College does **not** provide insurance for the loss of items that are not the property of the College. Examples of personal items not covered by College Insurance include:

- Musical Instruments
- Sports Equipment
- Computers
- Mobile phones
- Cameras
- Calculators
- Electronic Equipment

The College does not insure for individual loss, caused by theft, accidental damage or unexplained loss. Personal items, regardless of the need to use them for educational purposes are not the responsibility of the College. This is irrespective of whether the personal items are compulsory or discretionary.

While many students are provided with lockers for their use, they cannot be considered as secure. Lockers are designed for day storage of school books, uniforms and bags only.

Parents should take all reasonable steps to protect their own property. As such, expensive or costly items should be protected by separate property insurance cover, or an extension of existing home policies to cover personal items outside of the home.
