



## Visitors and Volunteers Information

Pedare Christian College encourages and welcomes parents, grandparents and friends to be involved in school activities, helping in a variety of ways including in classrooms, in the Library and at College events. We value our Volunteers and the important role they play in enhancing the learning experience for our students.

If you are visiting the College, we ask that you call into the Front Reception area upon arrival, where you can sign in and receive an official identification badge to display during your visit. This procedure enables us to ensure the safety of your children by identifying legitimate visitors to our College, and ensures your presence is recorded for your safety should an emergency arise.

### Volunteer Policy

The College has a Volunteer Policy which requires all volunteers to –

1. Complete a Volunteer Agreement Form relating to qualifications and experience and including names of referees
2. Complete a Child Related DCSI Screening Check for Volunteers
3. Undertake appropriate induction and Child protection training

Volunteers will be assessed for their suitability to work at the College by the Principal (or Principal's nominee). This assessment is made in relation to the skills and contributions being offered and only after verification of the person's good character.

The Principal/nominee's decision in determining eligibility to work as a Volunteer at Pedare is final.
