



You are advised of the special R-12 Easter Service for Junior, Middle and Senior Schools to be held on **Thursday 29 March**, prior to the East break. Parents and Caregivers are most welcome to join us for the service, commencing at 12:15pm in the College Chapel. The service will conclude at approximately 1:00 pm.

Junior School students will be transported to the College Chapel by bus. Following the service, they will be transported back to the Junior School by bus, and will be dismissed from there at 1:30 p.m. OSHC is available on-site at the Junior School from 1:30 pm – 3:00 pm, and from 3:00 pm – 6:00 pm at the Cobbler Creek OSHC; contact Cobbler Creek OSHC for bookings <http://www.cobblercreekoshc.com>. Junior School students can only be collected from the Junior School and will not be able to be picked up from the College Chapel. The exception is any students using the College Bus Services. Junior School families will receive further information regarding bus transport next week.

Middle and Senior School students will be dismissed at 1:00 pm. If your child is not able to leave the College at that time, the Catford Library will be open until 5:00 pm as usual.

All of the **College Bus Services** will depart from Surrey Farm Drive at approximately 1:30pm and all students who will use these services that day will need to catch the buses on Surrey Farm Drive.

Please note that the **Canteen Service and Wattle Café will NOT operate on Thursday 29 March** therefore students will need to bring recess. Students who are remaining at OSHC at the Junior School, or at the Catford Library at Middle and Senior Schools, will also need to bring lunch on that day.

As this service is a formal occasion, all students are required to wear their formal summer uniform. If students have Physical Education lessons on that day they will be required to change, PE uniform should not be worn for the service.

We ask that parents please observe the dismissal times, as outlined, and advise that it will not be possible to dismiss Junior School students from the Chapel.
