

Terms and Conditions of February 2023 Pedare Parents and Friends (P&F) Association Inc. Second-hand Uniform Shop

1. All items must be cleaned prior to being accepted for sale.
2. All items must be the current Pedare uniform to be accepted for sale.
3. All items must be in good to excellent condition to be accepted for sale.
4. The P&F Uniform Register (found on Pedare Christian College website or available from the College office) must be completed and signed prior to acceptance of items by the P&F Uniform Shop.
5. The P&F Uniform Shop reserves the right to decline any item that is dirty, in bad repair or not of saleable quality, this includes items that are marked with pen or paint, ripped, broken zippers, etc.
6. The P&F Uniform Shop reserves the right to determine pricing on items offered for sale.
7. 2nd hand hats, stockings, socks, satchels and library bags will not be accepted for sale in the P&F Uniform shop. Any of these items received will be deemed a donation.
8. If at any time the item of uniform being offered for sale is deemed obsolete from the current College uniform, this item will be donated.
9. 25% of all sales will be retained as commission by the Pedare Christian College Parents and Friends Association Inc.
10. Once accepted, items will be offered for sale for a maximum period of 2 years, upon which time any unsold items will be donated.
11. Remittance will be sent either by cheque, deducted from school fees or held as a Shop credit to be used at a later date (option needs to be specified on the Uniform Register) at the completion of Terms 2 & 4.
12. Cheques will only be issued for values exceeding \$30 (unless no items remain under your name).
13. If a cheque is requested as remittance, a \$3 administration fee will be processed.
14. It is the responsibility of the owner of the items to notify the P&F Uniform Shop of any changes to contact details. Cheques returned will be retained by the P&F Association Inc.
15. All items deemed "donation" will be donated to charity/ies or disposed of as determined by the P&F Association Inc.
