



Board Member Vacancy – Role Description

Pedare is a Reception to Year 12, co-educational, independent, Anglican and Uniting Church School. Pedare is located in the outer north-eastern suburbs of Adelaide, at Golden Grove, where there are currently over 1,150 students enrolled, and approximately 92 teaching staff employed. The College is structured into three sub-schools, Junior School (R to Year 5), Middle School (Years 6 to 9) and Senior School (Years 10 to 12).

Due to the upcoming retirement of long-term Board member, the Board is now seeking the interest of suitably skilled individuals who have a sound understanding of governance principles and board member responsibilities, with comprehensive* knowledge in one or more of the following skill areas:

- Legal/Regulatory/ Contractual: Understanding of the legal and regulatory environment applicable to the College and the ability to oversee regulatory and contractual requirements.
- Marketing/PR/Communications: The ability to contribute to the strategic marketing, positioning and branding of the College, a detailed understanding of creating value for students and families and the ability to assist in public relations and crisis management.
- Environmental Sustainability; Ability to provide guidance and oversight to the environmental sustainability plans and sustainability driven innovation of the College including familiarity with evolving standards and practices.

Pedare Board Members are passionate volunteers who attend 9 or 10 board meetings per year, plus a further four to six meetings per year as a member of a relevant sub-committee.
